The Outcomes of Teaching Holocaust Education

According to a University of Kent report, more than 65% of young Muslims feel more positively about Jewish people after taking part in the [Anne Frank Trust](#) programs. The report highlights that more than 80% of young people progress in their knowledge of prejudice, leading to a “significant improvement” in their social attitudes.

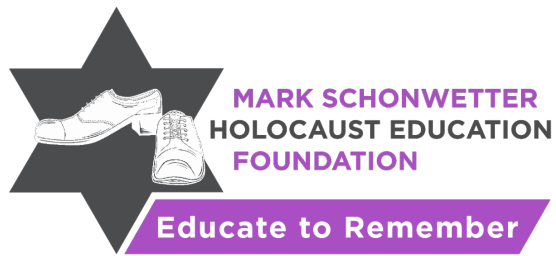
